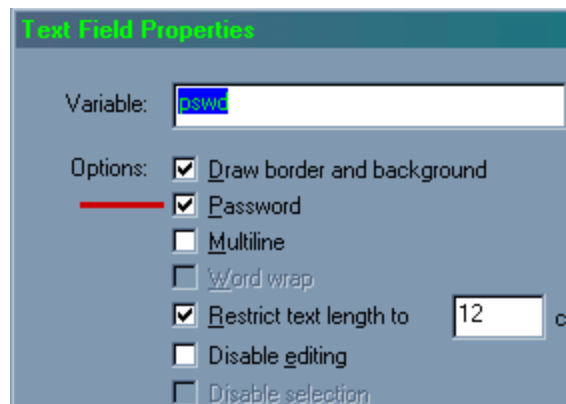
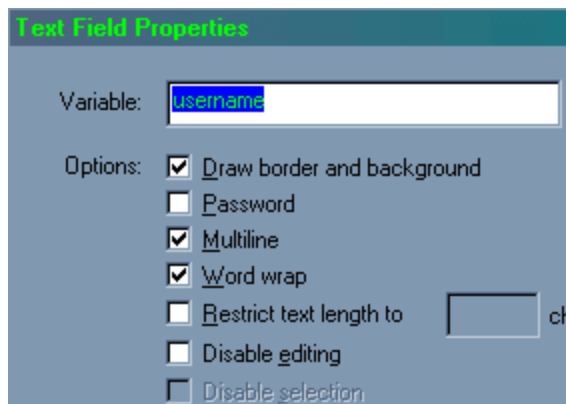

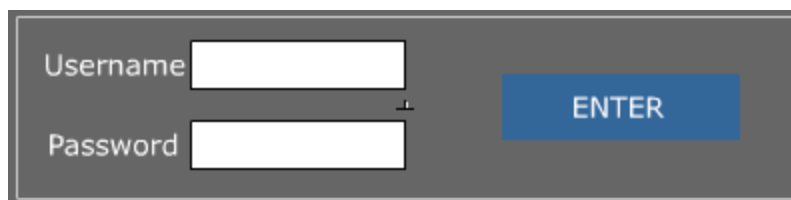
[NOTE: this flash password login is not very secure! Remember to remove the right click menu from you movie upon exporting]

#### Step One - Creating the movie clip

1. In a new movie, create a movie clip and name it to something like "pswd movie"
2. Apply a stop action to the first keyframe. In the first keyframe, create the look of your login page.
3. Make sure you include two text fields. One text field for the user name (assign variable: username) and another text field for the password (assign variable: pswd , and don't forget to select "password" under options for text field).



4. Now create a "Enter" button (name it anything you like). Then place this button into your "pswd movie". Here is what I have in the movie clip:



## **Step Two - Assigning the actions**

**NOTE:** For this section I suggest [downloading the .Fla](#) to look at the actions with.

1. Select the Instance Properties for the button you just placed.

2. Assign these actions to the button:

```
On(Press) If("user1" eq username and "enter" eq pswd)
Go to and Stop (2)
Else If("user2" eq username and "abracadabra" eq pswd)
Go to and Stop(3)
Else Go to and Stop(4)
End If
End On
```

3. Create the pages that the script specifies for the person to see. In this case, there is a page for user#1, user#2, and a wrong password page in frames 2, 3, and 4 respectively. Also, you can use Get URL instead of Go to...it's all up to you. To add more users, just insert another **Else If** and then specify what the username and password should be.
